STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND ONE CLASSROOM SESSION PER WEEK (6 HOURS) AND SHOULD PLAN ON AN ADDITIONAL 20-30 HOURS OF STUDY TIME EACH WEEK.
